

Earth-Connect

A multi-sensory, interactive, reflective trail created by
Janet Lunt and Chris Sunderland



Earth Connect is an interactive trail in the style of a labyrinth with ten 'stations' or stopping places along its route where people are encouraged to experience and reflect on some aspect of the natural world.

The trail is built around a highly accessible, 'light touch' Christian spirituality which is designed to encourage a broad range of people to explore their own thoughts and feelings about our relationship with the natural world¹.

The trail is designed for a large building like a church or hall, but individual stations can also be used in a classroom² or as a special part of a festival or exhibition.

The **Earth Connect** pack consists of a series of laminated cards describing how to set up each station plus a CD containing graphics that can be printed out and mounted onto boards. Setting up the trail is an artistic project and will require someone with an interest in style and form. It is recommended that hosts purchase their pack well before the intended date of exhibiting so they can consider how they want to do it and the materials they will require.

The **Earth Connect** pack is on sale at £30, including a licence for the use of the material by the purchaser in one particular venue, or £50 for use at up to three venues.

More on what you can expect in your pack:

We have tried to do everything possible to make it easy for you to put this on. Each prayer station is pictured on a laminated card together with details about how you can go about setting it up.

For example the Seeds of Hope station looks like this:



The laminated card carries a picture of the station together with a list of materials that you will need to gather to set it up, while the CD has the text and pictures (left picture) for you to print out and mount. With some of the stations there is more than one option according to what materials you have available.

We have also included various other instructions such as a 'Briefing for Hosts' with hints designed for those who oversee the venue during the event.
